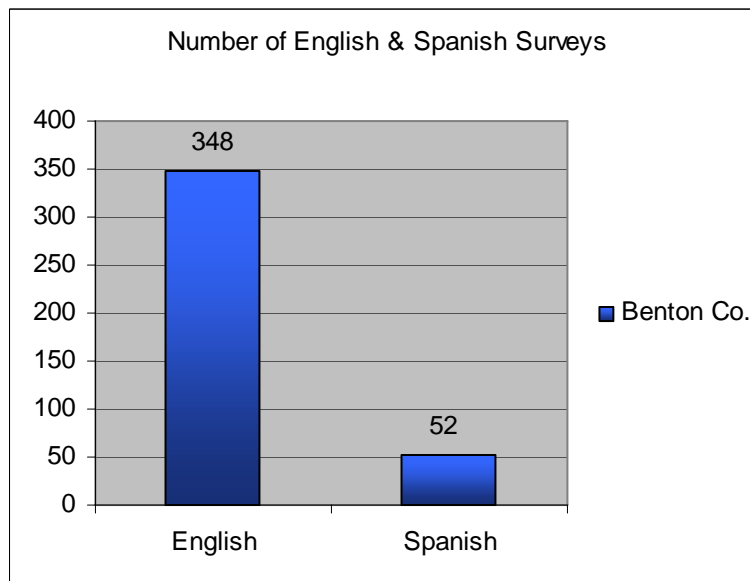

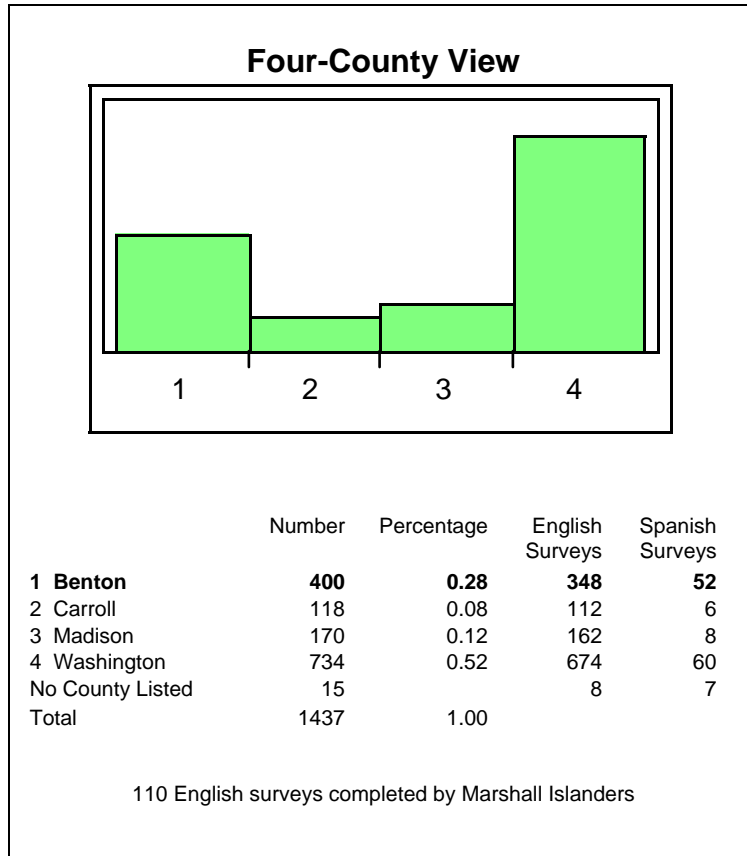

400 of the survey respondents say they live in Benton County



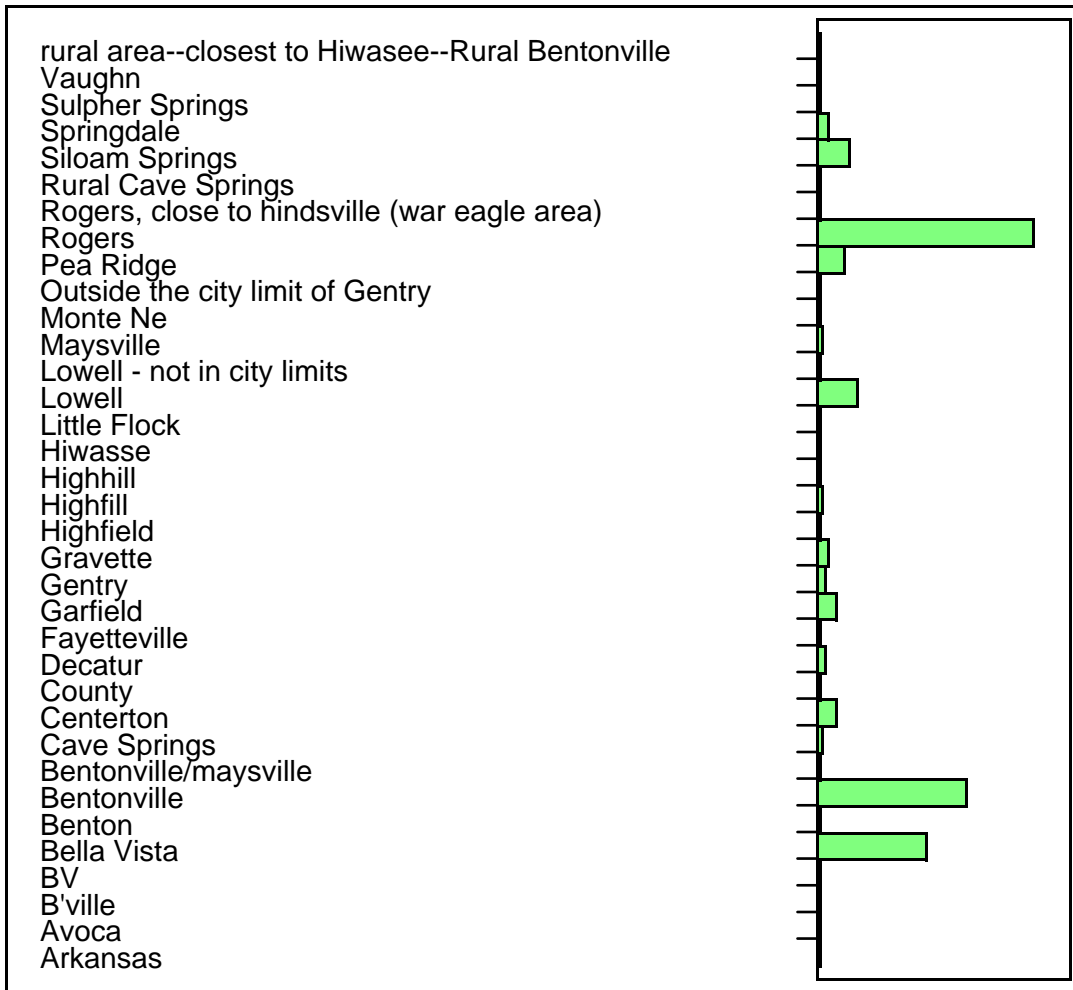

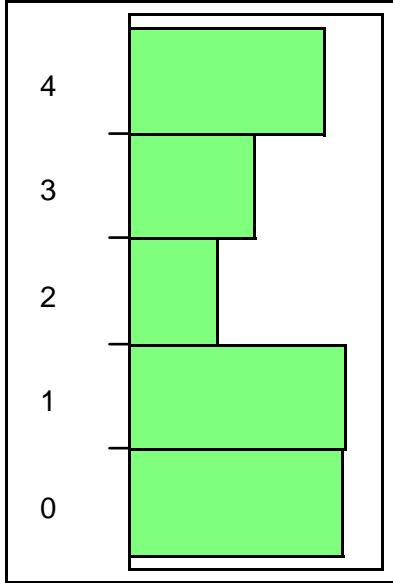

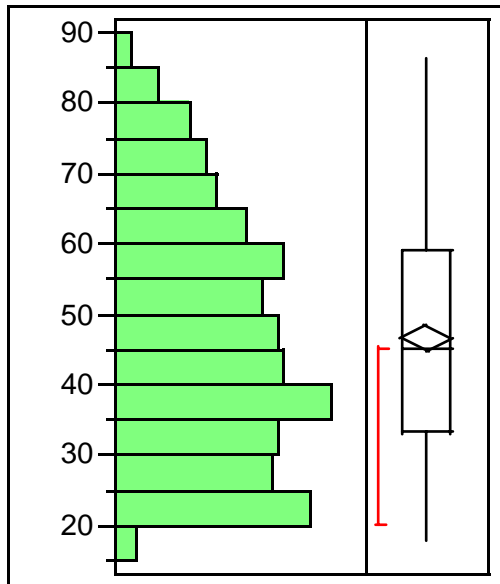
